




TRANSFER CHECKLIST FOR SOPHOMORES

Business Administration at UNC



Are you a sophomore transfer student interested in majoring in Business Administration (B.A) while at UNC-Chapel Hill? Here are a few helpful tips and recommendations:

Major Requirements // *If you plan to transfer with sophomore status and graduate three years after transferring to UNC, these are courses that must be completed prior to matriculating at the business school.*

- ECON 101 (Must include both microeconomics and macroeconomics to transfer)
- ECON 410 (Intermediate Microeconomics Theory)
- ENGL 105 (English Composition and Rhetoric)
- STOR 155 (Introduction to Statistics)
- BUSI 101 (Managerial Accounting)
- Any of the following: MATH 152, MATH 231, MATH 232, STOR 112 or STOR 113
- Note: Calculus must be taken at UNC unless a student has credit for both MATH 231 and 232.

Major Courses // *These are courses that need to be completed at UNC's Kenan Flagler program*

- BUSI 401 (Management and Corporate Communication)
- BUSI 403 (Operations Management)
- BUSI 404 (Legal and Ethical Environment of Business)
- BUSI 405 (Leading and Managing)
- BUSI 406 (Principles of Marketing)
- BUSI 407 (Financial Accounting and Analysis)
- BUSI 408 (Corporate Finance)
- BUSI 410 (Business Analytical Applications)
- BUSI 411 (Strategic Management)
- An additional 18 hours of business elective credit

Frequently Asked Questions about transferring into Kenan-Flagler Undergraduate Programs

Q: What does it mean to be a sophomore transfer?

If you transfer in either your second, third or fourth term in residence, you are a sophomore transfer. Another way to think about it is if you have five or more semesters left to complete your degree at UNC.

Q: How hard is it to get into the Business School?

Approximately 50% of applicants are admitted each year. Given the competitive nature of the undergraduate business program, students who are currently enrolled in business programs at other four year institutions should think carefully about their decision to leave these programs. Please note that while students may be completing their prerequisites in the term during which they are applying, admission priority is given to students with fewer prerequisites remaining at the time of application.

Q: Do I apply directly to the Business program with my transfer application?

No. Transfer students must first be admitted through the College of Arts and Sciences before applying to either the Business major or minor. All students must spend at least one semester in the College of Arts and Science before they are eligible to start at the business school. Students apply to business school early in their first semester at UNC.

Q: I'm planning out my courses - any advice?

Summer school might be a good option for some students as many of the prerequisites are offered in the summer months. Additionally, summer school provides transfer students with an excellent opportunity to acclimatize to life in Chapel Hill, both socially and academically.

Q: Does UNC accept online transfer credit?

Yes, we accept online transfer credit from an equivalent Carolina Courses Online for all prerequisites except BUSI 101

Q: Are their other requirements or experiences that are strongly recommended?

The business school looks for well-rounded students who possess the following: depth of thought and intellectual curiosity, a global mindset, a clear rationale for why business, leadership potential, and motivation and drive. Extracurricular engagement and community service are highly valued as is real world experience. Students will need to provide an updated resume and submit three written essays as part of their application. Students are encouraged to participate in one or more mock interviews to prepare for the required admissions interview.

Q: How will I know how my courses transfer?

Most transfer equivalencies will be determined through Undergraduate Admissions - but please note that the business school makes all decisions on credit awarded for business courses taken at other institutions, and this process takes up to three weeks. You should submit a Transfer Equivalency Credit Review form as soon as you accept your offer.

What is the application deadline?

All sophomore transfers must apply by October 1st. The application opens July 1st.
